# 1. Provider feedback – review feedback received and key findings:

- a. Capital Investments
  - Orange County to follow up with GoTriangle and DCHC to discuss requested cost share for RTC
  - ii. Investment in RTC could reduce funding available for N-S BRT
  - iii. Could include RTC on the vision map
- b. Operational Investments
  - i. Future study: county management of all on demand service to increase efficiencies (see Charlottesville/ Albemarle example)
  - ii. Determine if there is a rationale (or data) justifying improvements to HS or J
- c. Aspirational Projects:
  - i. NC 54 is currently the least viable corridor (discussed) for BRT

# 2. County recommendations for draft recommended network and plan:

- a. 400/405, D, and N-S service improvements are priorities
- b. Improvements to service on HS and/or J preferred
- c. Potential for MOD service enhancements
- d. 800 and CRX improvements are lower priority, along with vanpool and/or small-scale commuter services.

### 3. Conceptual vision map elements:

- a. Rural buffer limits BRT viability of many corridors in/out of Orange County
- b. Identify corridors with potential for "real" BRT vs. enhanced transit service

### 4. Measures of effectiveness:

a. Include tangible and visual examples (ex. change in access to UNC hospitals, isochrome maps, conceptual projects; use to relate the benefits of investments)
